**POSITION DUTIES:** This is the intermediate level of technical radio work involving the installation, repair and maintenance of transmitters, receivers, and related radio equipment in accordance with Federal Communications regulations. Employees receive moderate supervision from a higher level Radio Technician or Radio Technician Supervisor. Workers in this classification may be subject to 24 hour on-call duty.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

**EDUCATION:** Graduation from an accredited high school or possession of a high school equivalency certificate.

**EXPERIENCE:** Three years experience in the repair of electronic communications equipment of which two years must have included the repair of two-way FM radios

**NOTE:** Applicants may substitute successful completion of a one year program of study in radio electronics at a recognized training school, trade school, or college for up to one year of the required general experience.

**LICENSES, REGISTRATIONS AND CERTIFICATES:**

Candidates appointed to positions in this classification may be assigned duties which require the operation of a motor vehicle. Employees assigned such duties will be required to possess a motor vehicle operator's license valid in the State of Maryland.

## **SELECTION PROCESS:**

Only candidates who meet the minimum qualifications will be considered for this classification and will be placed on the Employment Eligible List as BEST QUALIFIED, BETTER QUALIFIED or QUALIFIED and remain eligible for consideration for at least one year from the date of examination. The list will be used by the hiring agency to select employees. **For education obtained outside the U.S., you will be required to provide proof of the equivalent American education as determined by a foreign credential evaluation service.**

The examination will consist of a rating of your education, training, and experience related to the requirements of the position.
