**DESCRIPTION:**       The main purpose of this position is to provide day-to-day Data Systems management including data analyses, designing, developing, implementing and controlling the database management system for the Center for Cancer Surveillance and Control's Breast and Cervical Cancer Program (BCCP). This position also provides programming and technical assistance regarding the data systems to the Breast and Cervical Cancer Program and staff. The data system is crucial to the day-to-day activities within the program.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

**Education:**       Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in Computer Information Technology, Management Information Systems, Computer Science or other information technology related field to include course work in database management systems.

**Experience:**       One year of experience designing, developing, implementing, maintaining and controlling database management systems for computers.

Graduation from an accredited high school or possession of a high school equivalency certificate plus thirty credit hours from an accredited college or university in Computer Information Technology, Management Information Systems, Computer Science or other information technology-related field to include course work in database management systems may be substituted for the required education.

Graduation from an accredited high school or possession of a high school equivalency certificate and one additional year of experience designing, developing, testing, implementing and maintaining applications systems and programs using generally accepted computer programming languages or maintaining and modifying operating systems for computers may be substituted for the required education.
3. Experience operating computer systems; or scheduling, controlling input and output or maintaining a tape library to process data on computer systems; or converting data from project specifications by developing program code using generally accepted computer programming languages may be substituted for high school education on a year-for-year basis.

### **Desirable Qualifications:**

Advanced knowledge and at least one year of experience with Visual Basic .NET 2005, SQL Server Administration 2005 and SQL programming, Microsoft Visual Studio and Windows Server 2003 is preferred. Experience must be noted on MS-100 application.
