RCIA – Rite of Sending & Rite of Election

On this 1<sup>st</sup> weekend of Lent, our Catechumens & Candidates celebrate 2 special Rites.

*The Rite of Sending* occurs Saturday evening at the 6 PM Mass. This Rite offers our parish community, their Godparents and Sponsors, the opportunity to express their approval of the Catechumens and Candidates, and to send them forth to the celebration of the Rite of Election, assured of the parish's care and support, as they now enter into the last phase of their preparation for the Easter Sacraments.

*The Rite of Election* is celebrated this Sunday at the Cathedral of Mary Our Queen. Our 5 Catechumens (those receiving Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist); and our 7 Candidates (those already baptized, who will be receiving Confirmation and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil), will be presented to Archbishop Edwin O'Brien this day.
